YEAR ROUND

Free and frequent transit service is available in Aspen, serving local attractions as well as the airport. Shuttles depart from the Rubey Park Transit Center, located on Durant Street, across from the Silver Circle Ice Arena. All bus service between Aspen and Snowmass Village is free. Bus service to other communities is available for a fare. Discounted Value Cards are available at Rubey Park, eliminating the need to carry correct change.

GETTING TO THE AIRPORT

Taxi and limousine services greet every flight at the Aspen/Pitkin County Airport. Many lodges provide courtesy van service to or from the airport and around town. Free RFTA buses also travel between Aspen and the airport.

FROM DENVER OR EAGLE COUNTY AIRPORTS

A variety of shuttle providers offer convenient service to Aspen and Snowmass Village. See back panel for contact information.

TRAILS AND PATHS

The Roaring Fork Valley is home to the Rio Grande Trail, a 44 mile stretch of scenic trail between Aspen and Glenwood Springs. Aspen's trail system is available year-round for hikers, cyclists, equestrians, cross-country skiers and more.

FREE ASPEN TRANSIT

The routes described to the below are FREE unless otherwise noted. For the most current transit schedule ask your concierge or call 970.925.8484.

KEY  = Rubey Park Transit Center



BURLINGAME/HWY 82 SHUTTLE

Provides service from Rubey Park to the Burlingame Ranch housing complex via Hwy 82. This route is a convenient option for reaching the Aspen Golf Course or Buttermilk Mountain.

CASTLE/MAROON

Provides service from town to Maroon Creek Road and Castle Creek Road serving Aspen Valley Hospital, Aspen Highlands Village and the Aspen Recreation Center.

CEMETERY LANE

Travels from Rubey Park to the Cemetery Lane residential area.

CROSS-TOWN SHUTTLE (Summer & Winter Only)

Serves the West End and Ute Avenue neighborhoods including attractions such as the Benedict Music Tent.

HUNTER CREEK

Serves the residential area of Hunter Creek, providing access to grocery shopping and Aspen's Post Office. Also travels near the popular Smuggler Mountain trail.

MOUNTAIN VALLEY DIAL-A-RIDE

Serves the Mountain Valley residential area on a fixed route free of charge. Provides door-to-door service in this area for \$1. Call 970.920.9999 to schedule personalized service.

MAROON BELLS SCENIC BUS (Summer Only)

A scenic and educational trip that travels from Aspen Highlands to the Maroon Bells. Ticket is required. Call 970-925-8484 or download the White River National Forest app for more information.



Great for quick trips around town! Your first 30 minutes of each ride is FREE. Sign up for 24/7 access to more than 100 bikes at over 20 stations. Start riding by downloading the app Transit@ or visiting WE-cycle.org.

PARKING OPTIONS

The City of Aspen offers both fee-based and FREE parking options.

HOW TO PAY

- Pay stations are located mid-block and accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover as well as coins and parking tokens.
- Display your receipt face up on your dashboard.

DOWNTOWN PARKING

Parking rates vary by season and hour of day, charging more during periods of peak usage.

RESIDENTIAL PARKING

The residential zones are just outside of the downtown core, offering a convenient parking value. Pay using a pay station, day pass or via app.

Day Pass hang tags are also available at several locations including the Rio Grande Parking Garage, City of Aspen Parking Department & City Market stores.

RIO GRANDE PARKING GARAGE

The Rio Grande Parking Garage offers 24-hour economical, covered parking. Parking in the Garage can be purchased by the hour or day. Ten-visit and monthly passes are also available.

Parking in the Garage is free from 5:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m. daily! During the winter season the free Galena Street Shuttle provides continuous service from the Garage to downtown Aspen from 8:15 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

FREE PARKING OPTIONS

- **6:00 p.m. – 9:59 a.m. daily:** FREE Parking in the downtown core and residential areas
- **Saturdays, Sundays and holidays:** FREE in the residential zones
- **Sundays and holidays:** FREE in downtown Aspen and the Rio Grande Parking Garage
- **Rio Grande Parking Garage:** FREE from 5:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m. daily
- **Brush Creek Park & Ride:** (At the intersection of Highway 82 and Brush Creek Road) With FREE bus service provided to and from Aspen. Call 970.925.8484 for bus schedules.
- **Carpools:** FREE parking for carpools of two or more adults displaying a carpool permit. Permits are available weekdays, from 6:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. at the Airport Parking Kiosk.
