

CLOSURE NOTICE

As part of the Galena and Main Street Bus Stop and Pedestrian Improvements Project, crews are trenching in the alley behind City Hall to tie into the transformer as a power source for snowmelt on the bus stop landing area.

Work in the alley behind City Hall will start on Friday, September 21st and is expected to last 4 days. The alley will be closed to through vehicle traffic, but open to pedestrian/bike traffic (see image). The alley will be fully open at night and during the weekend.

Phase 1 – West side of alley

- Friday, Sept. 21
- Monday, Sept. 24

Alley will be closed to through vehicle traffic. No parking on the West side of the alley. Garage entrances will remain open.

Phase 2 – West and Central area of alley

- Tuesday, Sept. 25
- Wednesday, Sept. 26

Alley will be closed to through vehicle traffic. No parking in the alley. Garage entrances will remain open.



The Galena and Main Bus Stop and Pedestrian Improvements Project aims to increase safety for pedestrians, enhance stormwater systems and update the bus stop. Key features include improvements to the existing bus stop, replace existing sidewalk and ramps to meet ADA standards, install new stormwater infrastructure, curb and gutter improvements, permeable pavers and snowmelt.
