

# Special Use in Parks During COVID-19

The City of Aspen Parks Department is excited to be working with local businesses to provide some opportunity for outside wellness classes while typical indoor activities are suspended. This program will be available during the summer months of 2020 until normal indoor programming can resume. Initial park requests will be considered through July and revisited at that time for continued use as needed. This program will not be available post-COVID. There is a one-time application fee of \$50.00 for this program (commercial park day use is typically \$197/day). The terms of use are presented here to set an expectation for all parties involved in this new endeavor.

This form is intended to help us understand the uses occurring in the parks. By submitting for a request to use a park, you are agreeing to the following conditions. A COVID-19 summer 2020 park use does not give sole use for that park. The City of Aspen Park system is available for the enjoyment of all citizens and visitors alike.

All users are required to follow current Pitkin County and City of Aspen health directives, ordinances, including group size, social distancing, and other COVID-19 related conditions.

Please also recognize that your use of the parks may be impacted by regular park maintenance, including: Mowing, irrigation repair, trash removal and general maintenance.

Irrigation schedules will not be altered.

Additional items to note:

Amplified sound/music is not permitted.

Parks are open to the public at all times:

Expect encounters with other citizens and pets.

Please be tactful with bystanders who attempt to participate.

Please maintain a clean site during and departure from park.

Please understand with early morning reservations the park condition could be affected by previous evenings usage.

Public porta-potties will be available in some, but not all parks.

Park use is limited from 8:00am-1:00pm

Class size is limited to 9 students and 1 instructor (or any combination of 10 participants max).

Afternoon/Evening classes will not be considered so that the parks remain available for public use during peak hours.

Use is limited to the following parks: Ajax, Buggy Barnard, Fox Crossing, Francis Whitaker, Glory Hole, Hillyard, Jenny Adair, Koch Lumber, Mollie Gibson, Newbury, Paepcke, Rio Grande, Willoughby, Yellow Brick
