**Subject:** Tents and Temporary Structures

### Temporary Structures

Structures erected for a period of 180 days or less are considered temporary.

Temporary structures of 120 square feet or more and accessory to an IBC building require a permit in accordance with the permit section of the currently adopted edition of the building code.

Temporary structures of 200 square feet or more and accessory to an IRC building require a permit in accordance with the permit section of the currently adopted edition of the residential building code.

### Tents

All tents are required to be permitted by the Aspen Fire Protection District and are regulated by the International Fire Code.

### Electrical Service to Temporary Structures and Tents

Electrical systems in temporary structures or tents open to the public, including systems supplied by portable generators, require an electrical permit.
